Comments must be **received by 5 p.m. on November 20, 2025.**

What to Include in Your Comment

Keep it short, respectful, and specific:

1. **Identify yourself** — include your full name, address, and mention that you are a resident or landowner in Wilson County.
2. **Reference the permit** —

“I am submitting this comment regarding the Springs Hill Special Utility District application to withdraw and export groundwater from Wilson County (Blumberg Well No. 1, EUWCD 10257).”

3. **State your concern clearly** — for example:
 - You rely on local wells or the Carrizo Aquifer for water.
 - You are concerned about drought, declining well levels, or long-term groundwater availability.
 - You believe removing water from Wilson County provides no benefit to local residents and poses risks to existing wells.
4. **State what you want** —

“I respectfully request that Evergreen deny this permit until independent studies show no harm to local wells or the aquifer.”

5. **Ask for confirmation** —

“Please confirm receipt of my comment and include it in the public record.”

You may **mail, hand-deliver, or email** your comment — and it's a good idea to call afterward to confirm it was received.

Why Public Comments Matter

Public comments let the district know that residents are paying attention, expect transparency, and want their water protected.

They become part of the official record and help the board understand how many citizens are concerned about this permit.
